Company to award business opportunity

A company founded 23 years ago to specialize in youth and sports photography will award a franchise territory worth \$20,000 to a retired or otherwise honorably discharged military veteran.

The franchise will go to the winner of an essay contest, TSS Photography said.

The winning essayist will get a franchise territory covering a population of 250,000 in the United States, \$5,000 in equipment, and training and promotional support, according to the company's Web site.

Candidates must write an essay, due no later than June 1, on what their service to the United States has meant to them, why they would be an excellent franchise owner for the company, and why they would like to work for TSS Photography.

"In the essay, the candidate will have to demonstrate a previous dedication or commitment to his or her community, including involvement in local organizations, donations to charitable causes, youth outreach [and] convey a previous entrepreneurial ambition," TSS Photography said on its Web site.

Candidates must include their service branch and the dates during which they served.
